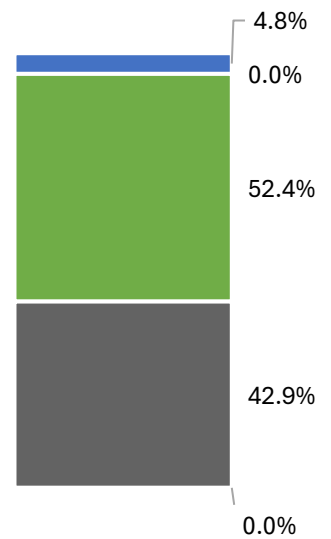

Language Spoken (Total Population)

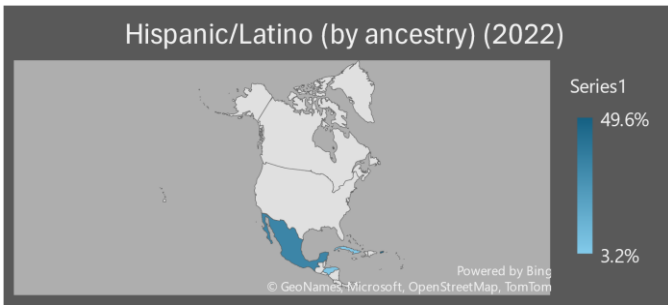


Language Spoken (Foreign-born Population)



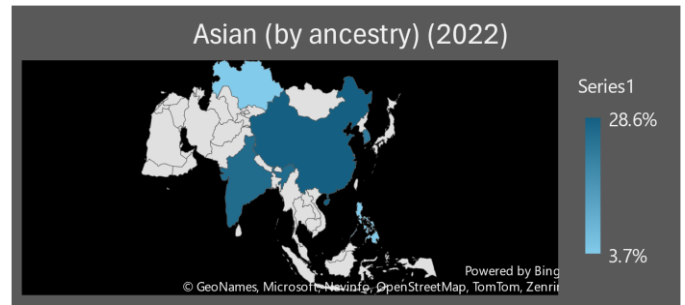

Top Countries for Hispanic/Latino ancestry



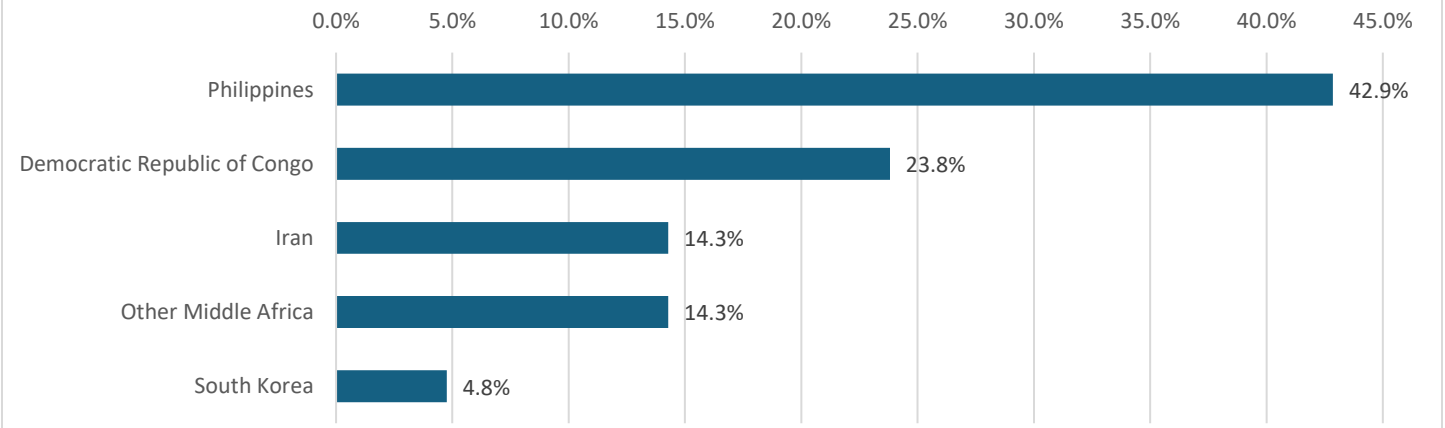
